

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(GARSINGTON PARISH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20****

NOTICE is given that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the order – in order to help improve road safety on local roads following concerns raised by the parish council – is to introduce a **20mph speed limit** throughout Garsington, replacing the majority of the existing 30mph speed limit, leading out of the village to the following points:

1. Denton Lane – a point 235 metres east of its junction with North Manor Estate.,
2. Oxford Road – a point 420 metres northwest of its junction with Poplar Close,
3. Pettiwell – a point 295 metres south of its junction with Oxford Road/The Hill,
4. Southend – a point 400 metres north of its junction with the B480 Watlington Road,
5. Wheatley Road – a point 105 metres southwest of its junction with the access to City Farm.

The section of **30mph speed limit** (approx. 500m) will remain on the Wheatley Road at the northwest end of the village, and the 40mph speed limit on the B480 Watlington Road will remain, with Officers having taken the current road environment & traffic usage into account.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Restricted Roads) (Garsington Parish) Order 1999 and the Oxfordshire County Council (B480 Watlington Road, Garsington) (40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2011 will be revoked/replaced as necessary.
