



WHEATLEY ROAD, GARSINGTON: PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council as the local highway authority under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers proposes to construct a Zebra crossing (a crossing for use by pedestrians) in **Garsington** at the following location to help improve pedestrian safety in the area:

- **Wheatley Road** - approximately 15*metres northeast of its junction with Denton Lane, adjacent to Garsington C of E Primary School.

*All dimensions are approximate, taken from the centre of the junction to the centre of the crossing.
